


So what is **SCOIR** anyway




- → Setting College preferences will help you customize your SCOIR profile
- → By adding criteria to the "Must Have" column, you can ensure only colleges matching that criteria will populate




- → Anything added to the "Nice to Have" column will filter to the bottom of the list and anything in the "No thanks" column will not populate at all.

College Details Overview

→ you can take a virtual tour by clicking the play button in the college's header.

General Information

→ contains details on acceptance rates, tuition, school type, setting, religious affiliation, residence, etc.

Admissions

→ contains data on SAT/ACT scores, acceptance rate, application requirements, deadlines, etc.

Student Life

→ Contains info on number of undergrads, retention rate, & diversity data

Academics

→ contains data on the college's undergraduate degree types, popular majors, and all fields of study.

Cost & Financial Aid

→ contains data on tuition, average net price, personalized cost estimates, loans, and financial aid statistics.

<u>Location & Transportation</u>

→ contains a map of the college's location, address, and nearest forms of various communication types.

College Wall

→ you can browse all the content SCOIR has curated for a college; including clubs, activities, and athletics.

Scattergrams on

→ Scattergrams display historic application outcomes for colleges when enough data is available.



- → You can add a college to "My Colleges" from:
 - Student Dashboard
 - ♦ College Search
 - ◆ College Details Pages
 - directly from within "My Colleges"



- → You can set the Acceptance Likelihood of a college.
 - Reach: your academics are below the average accepted student.
 - Match: your academics are of the average accepted student.
 - ◆ Safety: your academics exceed those of the average accepted student.
- → "My Colleges" is broken up into five columns depending on your status with that college. College tiles can be moved from one column to another.
 - ♦ Following: Colleges you are interested in
 - ◆ Applying: Colleges you plan to apply to
 - ◆ Applied: colleges you have applied to
 - Suggested: Colleges your counselors have suggested
 - Not Interested: colleges you are no longer interested in
